## 50m Trinity superyacht White Star sold

<u>Trinity Yachts</u> 49.9-metre superyacht <u>White Star</u> sold in a deal with <u>Ultimate Yachts Consulting</u> broker Dino Abbruzzese representing the buyer and Jonathan Barbe of <u>Edmiston</u> standing in for the seller.



<u>White Star</u> was delivered in 2004 from the United States and underwent a major refit in 2017 at the <u>Pendennis Shipyard</u>, United Kingdom where she benefited from an extension of three-metres and received an updated sky deck.

The tri-deck superyacht features both an exterior design and naval architecture from her builder, <u>Trinity Yachts</u>, with interior designer from <u>Dee Robinson Interiors</u>. <u>White Star</u> is finished with mahogany cabinetry and navy and white toned furnishings that give her a nautical appeal.

<u>White Star</u> is able to accommodate up to 10 guests across five staterooms, including a full-beam master stateroom located on the dedicated owner's deck. Her remaining guest accommodations comprise of two doubles and two twins, all of which are located on the lower deck.

In terms of propulsion, the motor yacht *White Star* is outfitted with twin <u>Caterpillar</u> 3512 DITA diesel engines that propel her to a top speed of 19 knots and a cruising speed of 13 knots. At the time of her sale, she had a last known asking price of €13,950,000.
